

## Braid Street-United Boulevard Bailey Bridge

### **Position**

The Chamber supports a temporary two-lane bridge connecting United Boulevard and Braid Street to replace the out-of-service one lane bridge until a permanent infrastructure solution can be found.

### **Chamber Actions**

**05/13/14** – Chamber indicates support for Transportation Minister Todd Stone’s proposal for two one-lane bridges at the Braid Street crossing.

**05/21/14** – Chamber sends a letter to Coquitlam City Council indicating support for a temporary two-lane solution, with a permanent solution to come at a later date.

### **Outcome**

The City of Coquitlam and the City of New Westminister are currently in arbitration over the issue with a Provincial arbitrator.
